The following result has been declared in respect of your candidature at the above examination. The relationship between this result grade and the standard of your overall performance in the examination is set out below. (If the word 'Void' appears in the result box, it indicates that not all components of the examination were completed.)

Result grade :	Pass
Distinction :	at least 65% in each paper at Part A and at least 80% in Part B
Credit :	at least 55% in each paper at Part A and at least 70% in Part B
Pass :	at least 45% in each paper at Part A and at least 60% in Part B
Refer :	less than 45% in either paper at Part A and/or less than 60% in Part B
Fail :	less than 45% in both papers at Part A and less than 60% in Part B (or unsuccessful in a previously referred component at a second attempt)

If you have been referred in one or two components you may re-sit just the component/s in which you have been referred providing that you re-sit within twelve months of the original sitting. Only one such subsequent attempt is permitted and, on successful completion, you will be eligible to a grade no higher than Pass. By way of additional feedback, except in the case of a Void result, an indication of your performance in each of the three component parts is set out below (an asterisk indicates that the result of a particular component has been carried forward from a previous sitting). The meaning of the performance indicators is explained on the reverse of this letter.

Component :	A1 - A2 - B
Performance indicator :	5 - 4 - 6

NEBOSH applies detailed and thorough procedures to moderate and check examination results before they are issued. It thereby ensures that the declared results are a fair and equitable reflection of the standard of performance by candidates.

There is, however, provision for you to make an enquiry about your result. Letters of enquiry (accompanied by the appropriate fee) must be received at NEBOSH within one month of the date of this letter. Details of the procedures to be followed and the current enquiry fees are available on request from NEBOSH. No information about a result can be given outside these enquiry procedures.

If you have passed the examination, your National General Certificate will be sent to you (or to your centre, where such an arrangement exists) in approximately two months. If you have not passed the examination and wish to resit, you should consult your tutor for advice on further study and examination arrangements.
